Vancouver's Said The Whale are currently bubbling under the Modern Rock, overall Rock and Canadian Emerging Artists chart with their brand new single "Heavy Ceiling."

The five-piece, featuring Ben Worchester

and Tyler Bancroft on guitars and vocals, Nathan Shaw on bass, Spencer Schoening on drums and Jaycelyn Brown on keyboards,



released their first album, "Howe Sounds/Taking Abalonia," in 2008 and was followed by 2009's "Islands Disappear" which has sold 11,000 copies according to Nielsen SoundScan.

The band, which won the Best New Group at this year's Juno Awards, released an EP, "New Brighton," in November and their new single, "Heavy Ceiling," will be featured on their next album, due in March, through Hidden Pony/EMI. Early believers on the single include The Verge, Iceberg, CFEY Calgary, CKPK Vancouver and CHDI Edmonton.
